The Flyin Ryan Adventure Scholarship Program

Flyin Ryan Hawks Foundation Adventure Scholarships provide support to young adventurers to align their lives with their passion. To date, we have made over 100 awards from \$300 to \$2,000 to adventurers across the U.S. Scholarship Awards are based on passion, character, expression of core values, and financial need. Applicants must be age 12 or older. Applicants less than age 18 will require the signature of a parent or guardian on their application.

REQUIRED APPLICATION ELEMENTS

- Completed **Adventure Scholarship Application** (downloadable from our website)
- Short **Biography** a 100-150 word profile, to be posted on the website.
- Personal **Essay** Tell us about yourself, your history as an adventurer, your passion(s), your current goal(s), why you want this Adventure Scholarship, and how your scholarship will be used
- List your personal set of Core Values. (For inspiration, see our website page 'Core Values Challenge' at: http://flyinryanhawks.org/promote-core-values/)
- At least one **letter of recommendation** from a coach, teacher, mentor, etc.
- **Two personal photos** High-resolution digital photo files in .jpg or .psd format preferred. One should be a head shot, the other an action shot or other full-body image. Links to high-resolution files on Dropbox or other cloud-based platforms are acceptable. Alternatively, send high quality prints, 3.5x 5" up to 5 x 7".
- Social media profile links (if you use them): Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube, LinkedIn, etc.

MESSAGE TO APPLICANT

We recommend you review our website in detail before drafting your application. See especially 'About the Foundation' http://flyinryanhawks.org/foundation/ and 'Our Adventurers' http://flyinryanhawks.org/our-adventurers/ for inspiration and examples. Use your creativity and media (video, photos, etc) as you see fit to paint a clear picture about who you are, and why you believe you should be selected as a Flyin Ryan Adventure Scholarship recipient.

THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN COMPOSING YOUR PERSONAL ESSAY/STORY

You **don't** need to answer **all** these questions! These are just ideas for you to think about:

- Describe a program you are in today (school, sports, community) and what it means to you.
- What is your greatest accomplishment?
- Describe your favorite adventure.
- Who are your mentors; how have they helped you?
- Describe your proposed adventure (what this scholarship would support) and what it means to you.
- What do Ryan's Core Principles mean to you? (*see our website at:* http://flyinryanhawks.org/meet-ryan/#RyansCVs for details)
- What steps will you take to prepare yourself physically and financially for your adventure?
- How do your parent(s) support your passion for adventure?

SUBMIT YOUR COMPLETED MATERIALS

Your materials can be submitted in electronic format, or printed and mailed. There are 1 or 2 documents that require personal signatures: A signed Media Release Form, below, is <u>required</u> of all applicants. <u>If you are under 18</u>, your Adventure Scholarship Application and Media Release Form <u>must</u> have parental signature(s). This form must be completed, signed as instructed, then sent by postal mail or emailed. There is no application deadline: We accept applications year round.
