These experiences, while demanding, have fueled my drive to excel in every facet of life, from academics to athletics.

Soccer became my refuge and source of inspiration. Unlike many players, I joined club soccer much later, starting on the E team during U15. Surrounded by players who had years of experience ahead of me, I initially felt the weight of being behind. But rather than letting this discourage me, I saw it as an opportunity. Every drill, every practice, and every game became a chance to grow. With relentless effort and a commitment to improvement, I climbed the ranks, earning my place on the A team in MLS Next U19. This progression is more than just an athletic milestone; it represents the values of perseverance, discipline, and self-belief that I strive to embody.

Balancing high-level soccer with a demanding academic workload has been one of the greatest challenges of my life. Maintaining a 4.2 GPA while training and competing at an elite level has required meticulous time management, unwavering focus, and a deep sense of responsibility. Through this balancing act, I've learned to prioritize what matters most, to push through fatigue, and to stay motivated even when the path forward feels overwhelming.
